

# **Service Vehicle Biosecurity Protocol**

#### Vehicle Wash

- ➤ Wash exterior including wheel wells.
- ➤ Wash all floor mats and "dirty box".
- > Clean brake and gas pedal and other potentially contaminated contact surfaces.
- > Spray floor mats, "dirty box", brake and gas pedal with Lysol or 2% Virkon solution.
- ➤ Rotate driver and passenger floor mats.

## **Vehicle Wash Timing**

- ➤ Vehicle are washed at a minimum once / week at end of week.
- > Vehicles may require additional washing during the week
  - When dictated by the next farm's standards
  - Manure exposure to vehicle, boots and clothes.
  - Exposure to disease epidemic.

## **Vehicle Supplies, Lab Samples and Farm Files**

- > "Clean Area" is designated in each vehicle and contains.
  - Farm visit supplies stored in clean Rubbermaid containers.
  - Pharmacy orders for delivery to farm in outer bag
  - Farm files, stationary etc for use at farm visit.
- > "Dirty Area" is designated in each vehicle and contains
  - Farm diagnostic samples in clean plastic bag or "dirty box"
  - Soiled disposable or reusable toe rubbers, coveralls etc

#### Farm Clothes and Boots

- > Clothing including pants, shirts, coats and hat are clean.
- ➤ Footwear is clean and in case of manure contact is washed and disinfected with Lysol or 2% Virkon solution. Provide two nights downtime in a warm and dry location.
- Toe rubbers or disposable boot covers are put on at vehicle at all locations and then upon return to vehicle removed and placed in plastic bag or "dirty box".
- Toe rubbers are washed and dried with work clothes and placed in clean area.
