

Instructions for Completing the Alberta Pork Registration Forms

Producer Registration Form

Business or Farm Name: It can either be the registered legal farm name or your personal name.

Primary Contact: The primary person in charge of the organization.

Additional Contact: A secondary contact that would know details of the operation if, for unexpected reasons, the primary contact was not available.

Publications

Industry Communications: will provide industry updates & information to producer on issues or policy.

Canadian Hog Journal: Free subscription to the journal. It is released 5 times per year.

All these publications are FREE and in accordance with Alberta Pork's privacy policy, Alberta Pork does not provide/sell its contacts to any other organization/agent.

Premises Registration Form

Registrant Name: Name of the organization registering the site.

Premises Name: Name of the premises. (eg. Hog Farm Ltd. Home Quarter)

Premises Identification (PID) Number: This will be the PID issued by Alberta Agriculture and Forestry (AAF). If you do not have a PID, please follow the link on the webpage to register online.

Legal Land Description (LLD): This will be the legal land description of the quarter section you are registering.

Premises Details: Indicate which type of premises you are registering.

Premises Facilities: Indicate the hog operation type of the premises.

Other Livestock: Please indicate any other livestock you have on site.

Premises Relationship: Indicate what your relationship to the premises is. A brief description of the three different levels is below:

1. **Operator/Producer:** Are you the organization that will be operating the barn and production facility? If YES, check off "Self". If NO, then please indicate who that will be.
2. **Hog Inventory Owner:** Are you the organization that owns the hog inventory on this site? If YES, check off "Self". If NO, then please indicate who that will be.
3. **Land/Barn Owner:** Are you the organization that owns the land/barn? If YES, check off "Self". If NO, then please indicate who that will be.

Current Number of Animals and Capacities

These two sections will appear the same; however, Alberta Pork is asking two different questions. In the current number of animals, we would like to know approximately what you currently have on site. For the capacity, we would like to know how many animals you could be producing on the premises if you were operating at maximum capacity. For outdoor operations, please take into account space as well as manpower.
