

WHERE CAN YOU SOURCE ANTIMICROBIALS?

As of **December 1, 2018**, Health Canada requires prescriptions for all medically important *Category I, II* and *III* antimicrobials.

The table below lists which antimicrobial products can be sold by each type of vendor. “DIN” refers to “Drug Identification Number,” assigned to all drug products sold in Canada for human or veterinary use.
eg. 02369540, Tiamulin fumarate (Vetmulin liquid concentrate)

In all cases, the products below require a prescription.
