**European pork production steadily declines** 

The pork production in Europe continues its steady decline. In the first 7 months of 2023, pork production in the EU-27 countries totalled 11.9 million tonnes. That is 8% less than in the same period last year. This marks the second year in a row of production decline, as production for 2023 is down by over 10% from the 5-year average. The EU commissions latest forecast for pig meat production in 2023 is that the year ends with 6.6 less%.

**EU Share of Pork Global Exports Continues** Decline

Lower production in the EU and China is mostly offset by larger production in Brazil, Vietnam and the U.S. EU pork production is forecast 2% lower year over year to 21.2 million tons. (Canva.com)





Canadians ate more pork last year than the year before.


Pork consumption per capita in Canada increased.

Pork remains one of the most affordable proteins for consumers




## **Domestic Consumption**


Canadians ate more Canadian-raised pork in 2021 than the year before.








- The imports share of domestic pork disappearance decreased from 39% in 2020 to 37% in 2021.



### Western Canadian Feed Recovery Assistance

- Hogs were not included in recent announcement
- No response from the province or Federal Government to Alberta Pork's repeated attempts to discuss the inclusion of hogs in the program

#### **Bill C-234**

- Amends the Greenhouse Gas Pollution Act
- Would create and exemption for fuels used to heat barns and dry grains

#### **Bill C-275**

- Act to amend the Health of Animals Act
- Add a new offence to protect farmers and the biosecurity of animals on their farms from those who enter their property unlawfully.

#### Bill C-282

- Amends the Department of Foreign Affairs, Trade and Development Act.
- Has the potential to sacrifice new markets for non-supply managed commodities

#### Bill C-293

- Act respecting pandemic prevention and preparedness.
- Suggests regulatory oversight is insufficient
