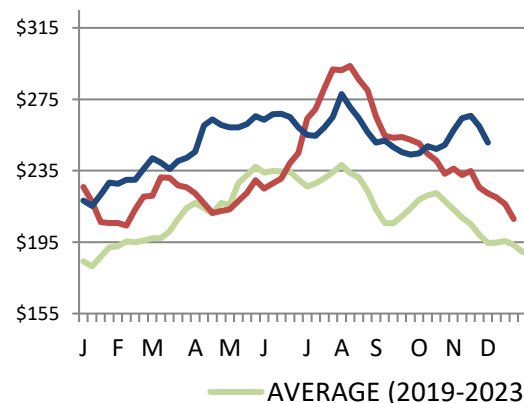

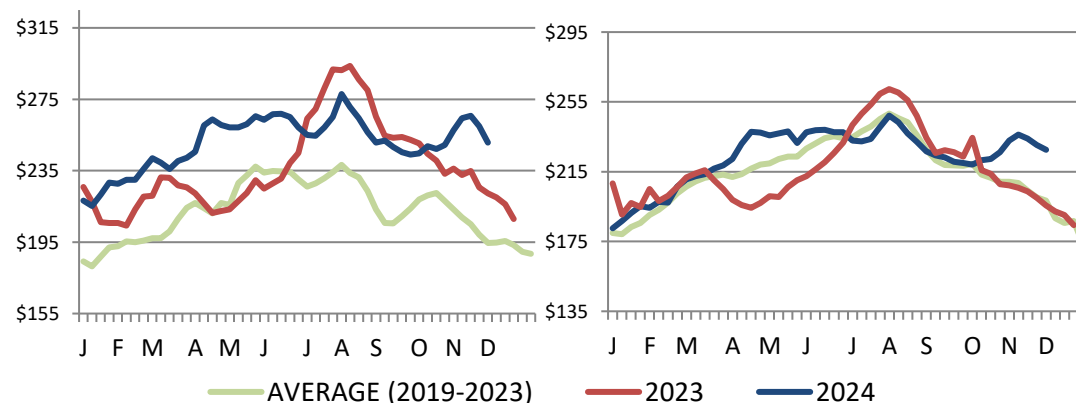

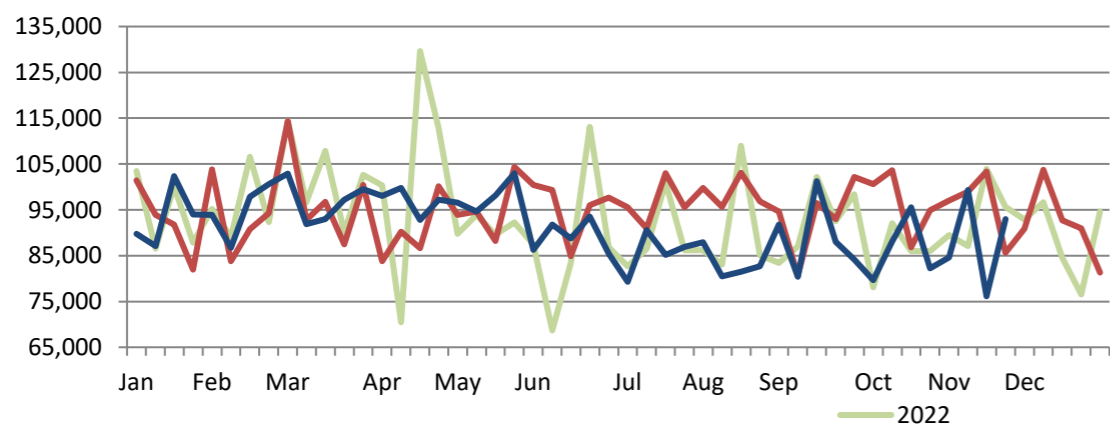

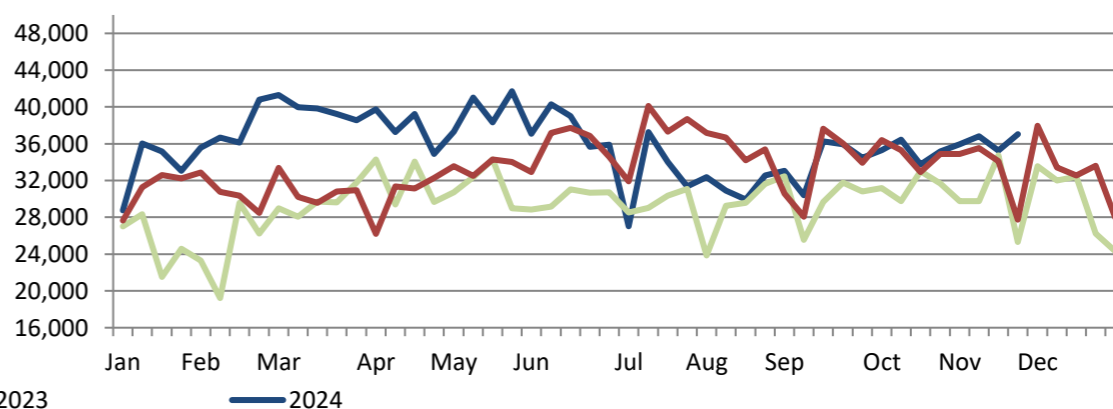

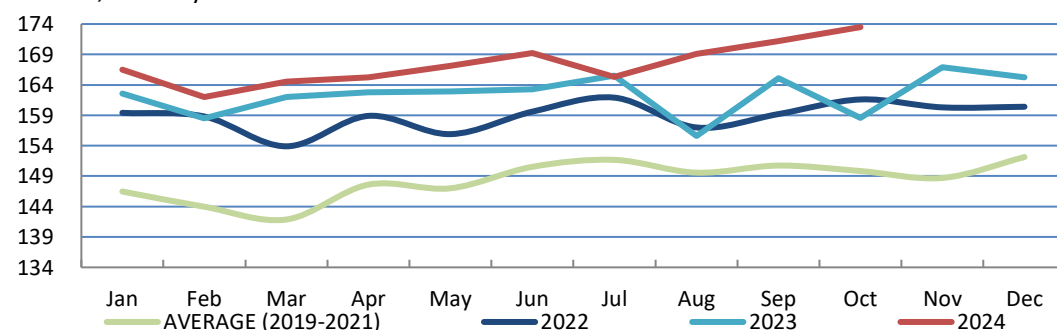

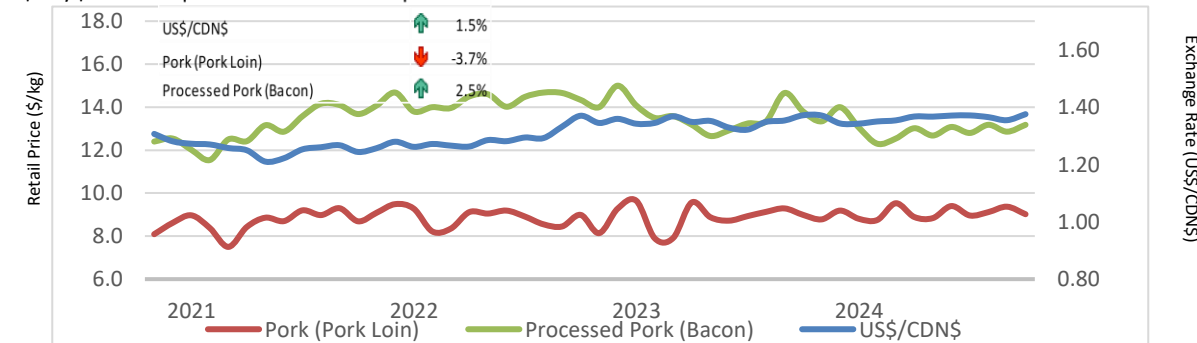

### Exchange Rate and Retail Prices for Pork Products

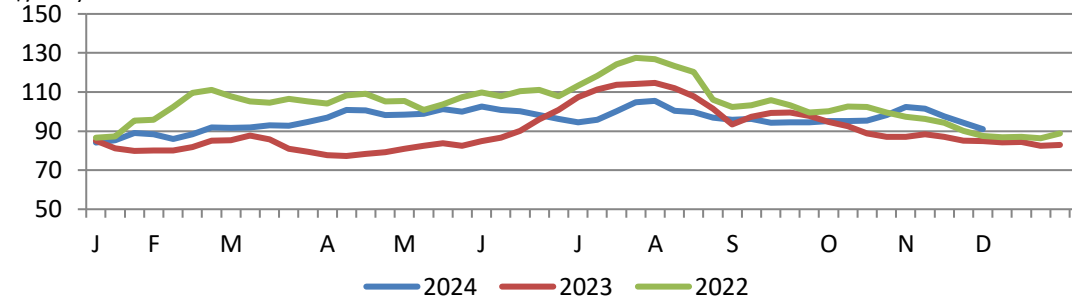
September - October 2024 comparison
