October 14, 2025

Weekly Hog Prices

US cash hogs varied however significant declines recorded late-week weighed on week-over-week changes with all ending lower. National cash fell \$2.32/cwt from last Friday, while the WCB was down \$2.44/cwt from the previous Friday and the ISM was \$2.43/cwt lower from the Friday earlier. CME cash was down daily, falling \$3.41/cwt under week-ago prices. Wholesale pork primal values were primarily lower, excluding hams which increased +1.5%, with US pork cutout ending -4.1% or \$4.46 lower to \$104.85 US/cwt from a week earlier.

Canadian market hog values were generally \$5-\$10 per hog lower on significant declines on hog prices and pork values. Quebec hogs were down the most, dropping \$10.65/hog from the previous week while those out of Ontario fell \$9.10/hog. The ML Sig 4 declined \$7.75/hog while Hylife hogs were down shy of \$7/hog from last reported. The OlyW 20 fell \$5/hog and the OlyW 21 R2 was down \$4.90/hog, while BP4/TC4 improved \$0.90/hog. In the US, Tyson fell \$7.05/hog while JM hogs declined \$5.10/hog from the previous week.

Weekly Hog Margins


Monitored hog margins weakened on lower hog values, however Canadian margins received some offsetting support from a decline in feed costs. Canadian farrow-to-finish feed costs fell \$1.45/hog while those out of the monitored US region increased \$0.30/hog from the previous week.

Hog margins off the OlyW 20 were down \$3.55 to \$92.85/hog profits, followed by those out of Ontario which weakened \$4.70 to \$88.70/hog profits. Hog margins off the ML Sig 4 fell \$6.35 to \$85.20/hog profits out of Brandon and \$78.80/hog profits out of Lethbridge, while Hylife margins were down \$5.50 to \$77.25/hog profits. OlyW 21 R2 hog margins fell \$3.50 to \$70.10/hog profits, while margins out of Quebec weakened \$9.25 to \$70.05/hog profits. In the US, Tyson hog margins dropped \$7.35 to \$79.85/hog profits while JM margins fell \$5.40 to \$70.60/hog profits.


