November 4, 2025

Weekly Hog Prices

US cash hogs continued to decline throughout much of the week - though overall moved more moderately compared to previously reported. National cash declined \$1.39/cwt from last Friday, while the WCB was \$1.56/cwt lower than the previous Friday and the ISM fell \$1.63/cwt from the Thursday earlier. CME cash again declined steadily every day, falling \$1.76/cwt under week-ago prices. Wholesale pork primal values were modestly lower, excluding bellies which rose +5.9% on the week, bringing US pork cutout -0.3% or \$0.26 lower to \$100.71 US/cwt from a week earlier.

Canadian market hog values were generally \$3-\$8 per hog lower on another week of declines. Markets derived from lagged base pricing were down the most with the OlyW 20 \$8.65/hog lower and BP4/TC4 down \$8/hog. Ontario hogs dropped \$7.30/hog, followed by the OlyW 21 R2 which was down \$6.70/hog. The Sig 4 fell \$6.55/hog lower, while Hylife hogs were down \$5.55/hog and Quebec declined \$3/hog. In the US, Tyson dropped shy of \$10/hog while JM fell \$5/hog from the previous week.

Weekly Hog Margins


Monitored hog margins continue to weaken on lower hog values and were further pressured by a notable rise in feed costs. Canadian farrow-to-finish feed costs rose \$2.10/hog while those out of the monitored US region increased \$1.70/hog from the previous week.

OlyW 20 hog margins weakened \$10.80 to \$64.25/hog profits, followed by those off the Sig 4 which dropped \$8.65 to \$61.20/hog profits out of Brandon and \$54.80/hog profits out of Lethbridge. Ontario hog margins weakened \$9.40 to \$60.90/hog profits, while Hylife margins fell \$7.65 to \$55.20/hog profits. Quebec margins declined \$5.10 to \$52.60/hog profits, while OlyW 21 R2 margins dropped \$8.85 to \$47.15/hog profits. In the US, Tyson hog margins weakened \$11.60 to \$50.15/hog profits while JM margins declined \$6.75 to \$42.20/hog profits.
