



# Weekly Regional HOG PRICE Report

November 25, 2025

## Weekly Hog Prices

US cash hogs declined much of the week, with national cash up Monday but down the remainder of the week and regional cash was down daily however went unreported Wednesday. National cash fell \$5.20/cwt from last Friday, while the WCB dropped \$7.37/cwt from the previous Thursday and the ISM was \$7.48/cwt lower than the Thursday previous. CME cash continues to decline daily with moves increasing as the week progressed, falling \$3.13/cwt under week-ago prices. Weekly wholesale pork values were lower in all primals, bringing US pork cutout -3.5% or \$3.40 lower to \$93.84 US/cwt from a week earlier.

Canadian market hog values were generally \$5-\$7 per hog lower on the week. Ontario hogs dropped \$7.70/hog, followed by those off the OlyW 21 R2 and out of Hylife which were each down \$7.30/hog. The OlyW 20 and Sig 4 each fell around \$6.75/hog, while Quebec hogs declined \$6.40/hog and BP4/TC4 was down shy of \$5/hog. In the US, Tyson dropped \$12.15/hog while JM plummeted \$16.20/hog from the previous week.

## Weekly Hog Margins



Monitored hog margins recorded another significant decline from last reported on continued declines in hog values. Canadian farrow-to-finish feed costs increased \$0.65/hog while those out of the monitored US region were down \$0.35/hog from the previous week.

OlyW 20 margins weakened \$7.45 to \$45.30/hog profits, followed by Sig 4 hog margins which weakened \$7.40 to \$43.75/hog profits out of Brandon and \$37.35/hog profits out of Lethbridge. Ontario hog margins weakened \$8.35 to \$40.55/hog profits and Hylife margins were down \$7.90 to \$37.15/hog profits, while Quebec margins fell \$7.10 to \$35.60/hog profits and OlyW 21 R2 margins weakened \$8 to \$30.35/hog profits. In the US, Tyson hog margins dropped \$11.80 to \$28/hog profits while JM margins weakened \$15.85 to \$15.45/hog profits.
